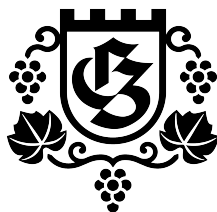

- 2004 Howard Park, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot - Margaret River, WA \$245
Dense blood red with a hint of purple on the rim. There is a hint of chocolate and blackberry. The palate has great weight and prescence with a fruit opulence and depth.
- 2006 Balnaves, The Tally, Cabernet Sauvignon - Coonawarra, SA \$295
A mid-deep red-purple tinge. Lifted nose, blueberry and blackberry fruit and perfumed violets with integrated cherry oak and a slight minty note. The palate is mid weight with bright red and blackberry fruit with firm tannins. Tannins still not integrated with the fruit but the balance is good.
- 2005 Balnaves, The Tally, Cabernet Sauvignon - Coonawarra, SA \$320
Deep red-purple tinge, big rich ripe fruit, liquorice and anise notes, spice complex and dense. The palate is big and rich, full-bodied ripe fruit with solid tannins and structure.
- 2003 Penfolds, Bin 407, Cabernet Sauvignon - Barossa Valley, SA \$325
Deep purple colour, nose aroma of raisin, menthol, prune, and violet. The palate is rich and densely packed with liquorice, toasty oak with dry tannins.
- 2005 Penfolds, Bin 407, Cabernet Sauvignon - Barossa Valley, SA \$325
Intense elderberry, ginger and spice with exuberant youthful fruit, dense tannins and vanillin oak.
- 2007 Balnaves, The Tally, Cabernet Sauvignon - Coonawarra, SA \$335
A deep rich red colour. The nose shows dark blackberry fruit with some cooler vintage black olive and liquorice notes. The palate is lean and tight with dark fruit and grippy grape tannins from the cooler vintage. A lovely balance of leaner / cooler style Tally reflecting the vintage.
- 2008 Balnaves, The Tally, Cabernet Sauvignon - Coonawarra, SA \$335
The nose is lifted with perfumed red berries violets and wild blackberry fruit coming from the Petit Verdot component. The palate is medium bodied and restrained in style with tight dense fruit and a modulated structure showing balance and depth of fruit, flowing onto a long finish of chewy tannins. This is a compact but deeply flavoured Tally with a high percentage of long maceration wines. 2008 was an excellent vintage in Coonawarra.
- 2009 Marsh, Vat R, Shiraz - Hunter Valley, NSW \$345
Well balanced and fruity red, dark berries on the nose with a soft smooth and rich palate. Chocolatey and rich tannins.
- 2004 Penfolds, St Henri, Shiraz - Barossa Valley, SA \$400
The bouquet is intense, dense and spicy notes of nutmeg and lavender. The palate is exceptional, ripe rounded and finely textured tannins with a long lasting length.
